NOTE: *1) Check the engine oil level at each fuel stop. If there is insufficient engine oil, add the engine oil up to the "F" mark on the level gauge. [Distance between the "F" and "L" marks on the level gauge represents about 1.0 liter (1.1 US qts, 0.9 Imp qts)].

*2) Clean the air cleaner element every 5,000 km (3,000 miles) interval. Under extremely dusty conditions, clean it every 1,000 km (600 miles) interval, and replace it every 5,000 km (3,000 miles) interval.
